



When we read each piece of writing in *Voice of Erudition*, it is also like walking through a door to the world of our students. Our junior students are becoming familiar with different text types and bring their playfulness and creativity to their writing. Our teachers nurture this creative spark and guide students in crafting their writing, until it is ready for publication. The writing process takes commitment and determination.



The room was dark and messy. But in the corner of the room, she found a beautiful doll. Grace found the doll so cute that she decided to take it home.






Never Say Die - Sir Isaac Newton

What is the book about?




What is the book about?



Furthermore, after the law is passed, marijuana will be bought and sold in broad daylight. Shockingly, people will even be able to buy baked cookies and muffins that contain that in the supermarket.

This is especially alarming when we hear what health experts have to say: Dr. Le Foll, a specialist in addiction in Toronto, warns that "cannabis is not a benign substance," and that 'there is a clear risk of addiction'. Other experts agree that the use of cannabis can cause many physical and mental problems like panic attacks and hallucinations.

Indeed, the legalization of marijuana can mislead young people into thinking that the drug is not dangerous or addictive. Bear in mind that people who take marijuana are also more likely to drink alcohol, smoke cigarettes and try other drugs. Research shows that people who are addicted to marijuana are three times more likely to get addicted to heroin.

Therefore, we should stand firm against recreational drug use. We should remember one thing that even something is legal, it does not mean it is harmless. We should never approve of the recreational use of marijuana. Thank you.
